CERTIFIED LAYSPEAKER TRACK OF STUDY

After you become a Certified Lay Servant, you may choose to begin the track of study defined by Book of Discipline ¶ 267.3.c. The track of study for becoming a Certified Lay Speaker requires that you complete Advanced LSM courses in each of the following areas:



- 1. Leading Worship
- 2. Leading Prayer
- 3. Discovering Spiritual Gifts
- 4. Preaching
- 5. United Methodist Polity
- 6. United Methodist Heritage

Be sure to check the LSM course catalog to determine if local course offerings fall under these categories. https://www.umcdiscipleship.org/resources/lay-servant-ministries-catalog

After initial certification, **any** Advanced LSM course is acceptable for recertification. Recertification courses should be taken every three years for Lay Servants and Lay Speakers, and every two years for LayMinisters.
